



# MANCHESTER COMMUNITY CENTER REOPENING GUIDELINES

## OVERVIEW

The Manchester Community Center continues to help fight against the spread of Covid-19. We ask that all individuals who use the center follow the guidelines below in order to ensure the safety of all those participating in events or activities at the MCC. We will continue to monitor state and local guidelines for holding community events.

Thank you for your patience as we navigate this uncertain time.

## GUIDELINES

- Masks are required upon entering the MCC and for the duration of your stay in the building.
- Everyone must hand sanitize upon entering the building.
- Please come alone to your activity or group, in order to minimize the number of people in the center.
- Only groups of 12 or less are allowed in the building.
- Please maintain a distance of 6 feet from others in the building.
- Bathrooms are limited to one person at all times, even for just washing hands.
- Everyone must stay on the first floor of the center.
- Take all garbage with you at the end of your activity.
- Do not use glasses, dishes or cutlery in kitchen cabinets at this time.
- **If you are feeling ill or have been around someone who has been sick, please stay home. Contact your instructor or group leader to let them know you will not be there.**

## UPDATED CLEANING PROTOCOLS

The MCC will be sanitized after each event and activity. EPA approved disinfectants will be used to clean all surfaces, as noted in CDC guidelines.
